STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

We expect our students to maintain high standards of personal conduct. This Includes:

- Personal honesty, discipline, integrity, humility, ethics and values.
- Students are accountable to the school authorities for their conduct in the school premises, for their general behaviour outside, while in the school transport and at all school approved events or activities.
- Any objectionable conduct on the part of the student will lead to consequences, at the discretion of the Principal, whose decision on such matters is final.

The following undesirable behaviour / repeated indiscipline will lead to serious consequences:

- Damaging school furniture, fixtures/building or belongings.
- Graffiti on the walls/school furniture/library books.
- Obscenity in use of words or acts and indulging in uncivilized behaviour.
- Irregular attendance.
- Scribbling or writing anything on the school uniform.
- Bullying, gossiping, playing pranks or using any form of physical/emotional violence against a fellow student.
- Insubordination to any member of the staff inside or outside the school.
- Using unfair means during a test/examination.
- Indulging in any kind of misbehaviour/misdeed directly or online which could be derogatory for the institution or any person.
